- 5 - You can't gallop on this horse; raising the kids is a dad's job too!
- 6 - Another name for the killer whale
- 9 - The smallest baleen whale in UK waters, measuring between 7 to 10 metres in length!
- 11 - The most sighted dolphin in the UK, and the most famous around the world
- 12 - Our largest seabird, often diving at speeds of 100km/h
- 13 - A giant of the deep sea with the largest brain of the animal kingdom; made famous by Moby Dick
- 14 - The biggest land breeding mammal in the United Kingdom, but their pups only weigh 14 kilos at birth!
- 15 - A smart-looking gull, who sounds just like its name, now a declining species

Down

- 1 - The largest species of the sea turtle, often chowing down on jellyfish and can live to be 100 years old!
- 2 - Also known as 'clowns of the sea,' because of their very flashy beaks
- 3 - With its knobby head, it's often seen breaching UK waters-- you can't miss it! It's huge at 18 metres in length!
- 4 - The UK's smallest and most spotted cetacean
- 7 - A medium-sized bird who spends most of their time out at sea, a relative of the now extinct Great Auk
- 8 - The largest shark in the UK!
- 10 - This shark is in danger of going extinct in UK waters, but a new breeding habit was found in Wales in 2019!
